Students May Choose Traditional or Online Programs

Traditional Program

Dayspring Christian Academy offers multiple academic tracks that include a wide variety of biblically integrated courses. Students who enroll in the traditional DCA Homeschool Interaction Program attend classes on campus in grades 6-12. Students in grades 6-12 are required to take traditionally taught courses in Bible, English, math, science and history. Additionally, a variety of elective courses are offered in foreign languages, fine arts, speech, drama, choir, band, technology, and physical education. DCA students have access to technology labs on each campus. Special art and science labs are available as well. DCA high school students may also choose to take either advanced placement or dual credit college classes in which they have the opportunity to earn college credit while attending high school.

DCA Online Program Options for Grades 6-12

Dayspring Christian Academy also offers a non-traditional online program using a biblically integrated curriculum developed by Sevenstar Academy for students in grades 6-12. The following is a summary of the two unique "online options," all of which would qualify students to receive a DCA "Homeschool Interaction" diploma and participate in DCA extracurricular programs:

Option 1: DCA Online, Off Campus Program

In this option students in grade 6-12 may take up to 6 online courses completing the work off campus. Students would be required to take proctored tests at an approved site. Students must be enrolled in a minimum of 1 DCA online courses, and may take other DCA tradition classes. A qualified online instructor will be assigned to each student for each online class in which they are enrolled. The online instructor will be available to set up the appropriate student learning pace, answer student course content and process questions via email, maintain periodic personal contact, and will complete all of the grading.

Option 2: Traditional DCA, On Campus Program with Online Opportunity

In the Traditional Homeschool Interaction program you may take DCA courses on campus and you may take DCA courses online
