Financial aid scholarships are also available.

Specific financial aid scholarships are awarded annually when enrollment is completed. Scholarships are based on completed financial aid application, the extent of need, and the availability of funds. Eligible families are encouraged to apply early, as scholarships are awarded on a first-come, first-served basis.

After enrollment into the school is complete, parents may request a financial aid application. Deadline for application is 30 days after enrollment to ensure full consideration.
