## 2026 Summer Math Course Registration

The purpose of the Dayspring Summer School Program is to provide advancement courses in mathematics for independent, self-motivated learners. The summer study is an online non-audio/non-video course that will be monitored by a Dayspring math teacher, who will set assignment and final exam deadlines and will hold weekly online sessions. Students who have graduated from eighth grade will earn 1.0 high school credit.

### Stipulations

1. Consideration for a math advancement course requires at least a 95% year average in the current math course, the recommendation of the current math teacher, and the approval of the math department chair and DCI.
2. Also required: A 75- to 150-word explanation of the reason for desiring a summer math (hard copy due with application).
3. Course offerings are dependent upon enrollment.
4. Tuition: \$450 (includes \$100 non-refundable registration fee at time of application)
5. Students and parents understand that taking a summer math course may require the student to take a similar generally independent online course during the school year (at no cost) if necessitated by the schedule.

### General requirements for earning credit Grading (weight)

1. Attendance at 85% of designated meeting times • Attendance/Weekly Journals = 20%
2. Completion of course assignments by their deadlines = 20%
3. Project = 20%
4. Completed final exam study guide with teacher review session (to be scheduled) = 20%
5. Final Exam = 20% Final exam must be passed.

**Note: A summer math student must earn a minimum summer course grade of 75% ( C ) to move to the next math course and, when applicable, earn 1.0 in high school credit.**
