Dayspring Christian Academy seeks to develop the servant character of Christ within the students by including a twenty-five hour community service requirement for graduation. The objective is to encourage our young people to show the love of Christ *outside of their church and school communities*. Ideas may include mowing a neighbor’s lawn, going on a mission trip, assisting with vacation Bible school, volunteering at a shelter or soup kitchen, or walking a neighbor’s dog. However, students are permitted to include up to 10 of those required 25 hours in activities *within the church or school communities*, such as teaching Sunday school classes, helping in the nursery, leading worship in church, setting up chairs for service, painting school walls during school hours, or tutoring a younger school student in writing or math. Check with Mrs. Hurley if you have questions about this.

All recorded hours—even those beyond the required 25—will be added to student transcripts. Students may start collecting their volunteer service hours during the summer before their freshmen year in high school. Note: **SERVE for EDUCATION hours do not count in these 25 hours.**
